Malawi Youth Project

NCMC is having a contest for Canadian youth to engage them in adopting compassion as a lifestyle at home and challenging them to think global and learn how they can, motivated with a Christ-like compassion, impact others around the world... specifically vulnerable children/youth in Malawi!

The contestants will create a 3 min video clip giving a testimony of how they have been changed and what they've done in connection with these 2 key areas of focus.

- 1) Adopting compassion as a lifestyle right in your own homes, schools, churches and neighbourhoods.
- 2) What you did to raise money and awareness for the Malawi youth project and how much money you raised.

The videoclips are to be posted on the Facebook group- "Nazarene Youth Contest - Malawi Youth Project" between Dec 15 and midnight Dec 31st, 2011. Groups of 2 or 3 are permitted but keep in mind only 4 from each district can win!

Funds raised by each contest applicant need to be submitted to: Church of the Nazarene Canada, Unit #9, 20 Regan Road, Brampton, Ontario, L7A 1C3 along with a contest entry form which can be found on the Facebook page or by emailing jgetson@firstonsite.ca and requesting a copy. Funds must be postmarked no later than Dec. 22, 2011 and clearly marked Malawi Youth Project. Winners need to do BOTH (post the video on facebook and submit funds/contest entry form)

Winners will be selected from each District (Quebec/Atlantic are considered one) as long as the district as a whole raises \$5,000.00 for the Malawi project. Four winners will receive \$1,000.00 NCM prize money each toward an NYI youth team going to visit the Malawi project in person in the summer of 2012. The District leader will receive \$1,000.00 NCM prize money as well, to take part in Malawi trip, as long as their district meeting the min. \$5,000.00 raised. The trip will be an **NYI district sponsored mission trip** and NCMC will only be providing cash as prize money to successful applicants in districts who meet the criteria. NCMC accepts no liability in connection with the trip by providing prize money for this contest. NCMC assumes no risk or liability in any actions taken to participate in this contest.

When does this contest begin? **NOW! As soon as you leave NYC, get started!** You **MUST** make note on the Facebook page of your desire to take part in the contest (We want to know who is involved!) to be eligible to be chosen, upon your later submission of your video and fundraising monies.

Who is eligible? Youth entering grade 10 in fall 2012 up to age 20 in 2012.

How can I get more info on the actual Malawi Project? Information regarding the project will be regularly added to the facebook group, keep watching for more details to unfold. The project is to start a Child Development Center (CDC) for orphans and at risk children/youth which will provide holistic care including feeding program and educational support.

Why Malawi? NCMC is working on this new project to support a CDC in Malawi and felt it was a great fit for a NCM/NYI partnership. Youth have supported World Vision 30 Hr famine projects recently which have been in Malawi as well.

Contest rules are subject to change at any time as seen fit by NCMC. Applicants must be an active member in local Nazarene Church NYI.
